PORT AUTHORITY POLICE OFFICER

The Port of Beaumont

Salary Range: \$50,000-\$55,000 Annually

FLSA: Non-exempt

Compensation also includes excellent health, dental, vision and life insurance plans, retirement through the Texas County and District Retirement System, paid holidays, and an optional deferred compensation plan.

All uniforms and equipment provided by the Port.

Duties: Secure the Port of Beaumont against terrorism, accidents, thefts, fire, or other illegal activities by applying knowledge of approved police procedures as best suited for the daily operations and cargo movements within the Port. Investigate criminal activity and accidents, and writing detailed incident reports. Must be available for nights, weekends, and holiday shifts as required. This is a non-supervisory position, however, successful candidate will work with contract security personnel.

Credentials: Minimum qualifications include a high school diploma or GED equivalent, a current certification by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards & Education. A minimum of two years' experience as a police officer is preferred, but not required. Candidates with a degree from an accredited university or college, FTO certification, TCLEOSE certified instructors permit and ADVANCED or Masters TCLEOSE certification will be considered favorably.

Physical Requirements: Medical/physical fitness shall be maintained so that the individual's health will allow him/her to perform all tasks or duties of a police officer. The employee shall be required to pass a medical/physical fitness examination in order to determine an individual's health/fitness as it relates to the successful performance of the job.
